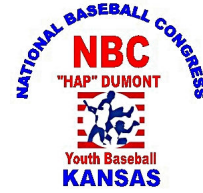


## 2019 Southwest Boys Club/Park City Tournament Rules and Regulations

**All tournaments are NBC affiliated tournaments and NBC rules apply.**

- Coaches must declare before the game whether they will bat 9, bat 10 (with an EH), or bat the whole lineup. Substitution rules apply. Machine pitch must bat all.
- Warm up prior to the game allowed in three places: Batting cage, tee-ball field, or the park across the street.
- Every team must supply one new NFHS approved baseball per game.
- All birth certificates and rosters are due one hour prior to your teams' first game. No exceptions. You are required to leave a copy of the roster with the tournament director. Rosters must include: First name, last name, birth date, and player number.
- Tournament gate fees: \$5 person for one day. \$9 person for entire tournament. Kids 10 and under are free. There is only one entry to the complex; anyone not using that entrance will be asked to leave immediately. **NO REFUNDS** on gate passes.
- In the case of inclement weather, the coaches will be called and notified of any changes. The tournament format may be changed if weather prohibits the original schedule.
- No profanity, pets, smoking, alcoholic beverages, fence climbing, and other horseplay are permitted at the complex. Please stay off of other fields not being used.
- Southwest Boys Club/Park City is not responsible for any damage done to vehicles or personal property.
- Team refund policy: one game played is a 50% refund. Two games played is no refund. If a team withdraws from a tournament within 1 week of tournament date, no refund. If a tournament is not completed, NBC will award points based upon their rules and regulations.
- Three coaches' passes issued to each team. They can be picked up at the store or mailed. **No tournament coach passes will be given at the complex.**
- Any forfeit during tournament play for not playing a scheduled game will be a 10-0 loss.
- No infield prior to the game.
- Mercy rules: 8-under, 10-under, 12-under – 15 runs after 3 innings, 10 runs after 4 innings. 14-under – 12 runs after 4 innings, 10 runs after 5 innings. Mathematical run rule will apply as well.
- 5 Run limit per inning for all divisions. If a Home Run over the fence happens to exceed the 5-run limit they all count. Mathematical run rule applies (games do NOT continue, waiting for Home Run).
- Time limits: 8-under: One hour, fifteen minutes. 10-under, 12-under and 14-under: One hour, thirty minutes. No new inning will start after the time limit.
- Brackets will be determined by number of teams in a division.
- May 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 is the cutoff date for all age divisions. Players must be at or under the age limit on that date.
- Teams may not add players after tournament starts.
- Games may start up to 30 minutes early, and is at the tournament directors' discretion. As we try to work very hard to stay on time, please have your team ready to play.
- Home team is determined by coin toss prior to game. Home team will keep official scorebook.
- Coaches: Please help us keep the dugouts clean and clean up after your team.



- If there are any sportsmanship issues with coaches and parents, they will receive one warning. The next time they will be asked to leave the complex.
- Official time will start when the 1<sup>st</sup> warm up pitch of the game is thrown.
- 10-U Division only: Each pitcher will receive one warning per game for a balk. After the warning, normal balk rules apply. This rule will not apply to the 10-U State Tournament.

- Courtesy Runners: Catcher only with 2 outs.
- 3<sup>rd</sup> to 1<sup>st</sup> move from pitcher IS NOT ALLOWED.
- Bat Restrictions: 14U, 12U, 10U and 8U **are allowed** to use 2  $\frac{3}{4}$  , 2  $\frac{5}{8}$  or 2  $\frac{1}{4}$  bats for all divisions.
- All Divisions complete game is 3 innings.
